

# Eperosa

## 2009 Elevation

100% Eden Valley Shiraz sourced from the Mibus 'Stonehut' vineyard which lies at an elevation of 365m. While not cool climate, this elevation above the Barossa Valley floor does extend the period of fruit maturation allowing optimum flavour ripening. The site has lean, rocky soils with an easterly facing slope helping to moderate the summer's afternoon heat. The wine was matured for 18 months in 100% aged French oak.

No fining or filtration. 1600 bottles filled.

### - *Tasting Notes* -

**Eyes:** Dense purple red

**Nose:** Rich cherry, star anise, dark chocolate, French oak, violets and pepper

**Mouth:** Succulent cherries, dark chocolate and subtle white pepper. Juicy, fresh mid palate with fine pure fruit tannin out the finish

**Food Match:** Rib eye steak, Pork medallions, Mild cheeses
